Students attending the five member universities (UVic, UBC, SFU, UA, UC) typically do not need to apply under the WDA (some exceptions apply – BMSC will notify you).

There are **two steps** to register for a BMSC course:

- Follow the procedure described on the WDA web page: <u>Application Process</u>. After filling out the WDA Authorization and Course Registration form, your home university must forward the form to the University of Victoria's <u>Graduate Admissions and Records</u> department. This process can take some time, so we recommend that you submit the form at least six weeks prior to the commencement of the course(s) requested.
- 2. If you are approved, **UVic will register you** for the BMSC course(s) you have been authorized to take. Do not register yourself online. You do not have to pay deposits or additional tuition if your university is a member of the WDA.
