

Graduate Students attending a PMSA Member University (UVic, UBC, SFU, UAlberta, UCalgary)

The majority of BMSC field courses are undergraduate level courses – if your BMSC field course is an undergraduate course, please consult the undergraduate registration information document. Please also ensure that you have permission from your program to take undergraduate courses.

Register at your home university for the course(s) for which you have been accepted.

Your university course registration numbers will be included with your acceptance message from BMSC. Specific information for each PMSA member university can be found below:

University of Victoria students:

You will need to login to [UVic's online services](#) to register. For more information about registration, see UVic's guide on [graduate registration](#). If you have trouble registering (i.e. trouble with pre-requisites), contact the BMSC [University Programs office](#).

University of British Columbia Vancouver students:

Before March 31st, login to the [UBC Student Service Centre](#) using Workday to pay your registration deposit. In early April, the Senior Biology Program Assistant will complete your registration for BMSC courses.

University of British Columbia Okanagan students:

Most courses at the BMSC are offered through UBC's Vancouver campus. Because of this, students coming to the BMSC from UBC-Okanagan will need to complete a [cross-campus registration request](#) to take BMSC courses. Before March 31st, login to the [UBC Student Service Centre](#) using Workday to pay your registration deposit. In early April, the Senior Biology Program Assistant at UBC Vancouver will complete your registration for BMSC courses.

Simon Fraser University students:
